Boone scores a 4Q TD to help Berlin in comeback victory!!

Aaron Boone made a 12 yard TD catch with 7 minutes left in the 4th quarter to bring the Thunder to within one point of the Rhein Fire. A blocked extra point attempt kept Rhine ahead 28-27. A Thunder interception deep in Fire territory with under 3 minutes left led to a field goal to put the Thunder ahead and on to victory 30-28. Berlin scored 16 points in the 4th quarter for their come from behind victory.

For the game, Aaron caught 4 passes for 49 yards and a touchdown. His longest reception of the day was a 16 yard catch in the 3rd quarter. He also had a 12 yard reception in the 3rd quarter and a 9 yard snag in the 1st quarter. Aaron also contributed on special teams with 2 tackles.

Berlin is now in a three way tie for first with Amsterdam (who beat them last week) and Cologne, who they will play on May 8.
