## Boone gets 4 receptions in a thrilling game against Amsterdam Admirals

Aaron Boone caught 4 passes for 72 yards, including his longest reception of the season, in a thriller against Amsterdam. The game ended with Berlin stopping a last minute goal line stand by Amsterdam that would have given them the lead and most likely the game. However, Jermaine Mays nabbed a pass in the end-zone and ran it back 100 yards for a thrilling touchdown that left Amsterdam stranded with just 7 seconds remaining. The final score was Berlin 27, Amsterdam 16. The win leaves the Berlin Thunder in sole possession of 1<sup>st</sup> place midway through the season.

Aaron started off the game immediately with a Special Teams tackle on the initial kickoff of the game. With about 4 minutes left in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter Aaron caught an 8 yard pass from Ragone for a first down. He didn't get another catch until the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter. Two minutes into the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter Aaron made a catch and went for 47 yards, his longest reception of the season. Unfortunately, he was tackled and fumbled the ball. It was recovered by Amsterdam. Aaron next caught an 6 yard pass from Ragone with about 8 minutes left in the game. He then caught another pass from Ragone in the same set for 11 yards that led to a first down. Aaron was pushed out of bounds on the Amsterdam 16. 3 plays later Berlin got a field goal to put them into the lead 20-16 with just over 4 minutes left in the game.

Amsterdam went 4 and out, and then Berlin did the same. Then, after the punt Amsterdam drove all the way from their 40 to the Berlin 6, with just 23 seconds left. Amsterdam's 3<sup>rd</sup> down pass to the end zone was picked off by Mays and he ran it back 100 yards for the final score of the game.
