Boone scores first TD of the game

Aaron Boone caught the first TD pass of the game, a 13 yard zinger from Joe Germaine. It appeared that the Blaze would power their way into a divisional playoff as they jumped to a 14-0 lead after a 15 yard TD to McKelvey. But the Crush fought back and it went back and forth until the fourth quarter and the Crush defense held tight.

Over the course of the game, Boone caught 5 passes for 77 yards. He also had 1 tackle in the game.

Blaze Head Coach Danny White resigns

After the Blaze loss to Colorado, Head Coach Danny White resigned. His resignation was accepted by the Blaze management. He had been the only head coach the Blaze had over their 3 year history, though during that period he never had a winning season. Utah went 21-30 over the three years and were 0-3 in the playoffs. The Blaze have yet to announce his replacement.
