

Kentucky Football Notebook - May 17

Three Kentucky football players, defensive end Tedd Bullock, wide receiver Lonnell Dewalt, and linebacker Gabriel Wallace, will not return for the 2005 season, Coach Rich Brooks has announced.

The three players were freshmen in 2004. Bullock and Wallace spent the season as redshirts. Dewalt played in all 11 games, caught 11 passes for 122 yards and one touchdown, and blocked seven kicks on special teams (six field goals and one extra point).

Boone Named NFL Europe Player of the Week: Former Kentucky wide receiver Aaron Boone has been named NFL Europe Offensive Player of the Week after catching eight passes for 112 yards and one touchdown in Berlin's 24-15 victory over Rhein last Saturday.

For the season, Boone has caught 26 passes for 363 yards and three TDs in helping lead Berlin to a 5-2 record. Boone also played for Berlin last season when the Thunder won the World Bowl championship.

Two other former Wildcats, defensive tackle Jeremy Caudill and kicker Stephen Scaldaferrri, are playing in NFL Europe. Caudill has made 16 tackles for the Amsterdam Admirals. Scaldaferrri leads the Frankfurt Galaxy in scoring with 25 points, including five-of-eight field goals.
